I. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

NOTE: Above schedules may change as the need arises.

II. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

All participants are required to fill out the official entry forms to be downloaded from the official Batang Pinoy website:

- 1. Batang Pinoy Athlete Entry Form and Waiver
- 2. Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate (NSO or Local Civil Registrar)
- 3. LGU endorsement from any of the following: Governor, Mayor, Municipal Sports Official
- 4. LGU ENTRY FORMS (to be downloaded from the Batang Pinoy website)
- 5. Batang Pinoy Taekwondo Contestant's Application Form and Waiver

III. KYORUGI EVENT

A. Qualifications For Participation

1. <u>AFFILIATION:</u> Only players of affiliated clubs, gyms and schools in the Advance Division (red, brown, and black belt) in good standing with the Philippine Taekwondo Association may join the competition. *Participants must be properly accredited or endorsed by their respective LGU's.*

FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT ENTRIES (province or chartered city): Applications shall be coursed through the Sports Office of the LGU. Each LGU may field in a maximum of four (4) players per category.

2. Kyorugi players are not allowed to participate in the Poomsae event.

3. WEIGH-IN: All players shall undergo weigh-in.

4. AGE REQUIREMENT: Players who are 12-15 years old

5. <u>DIVISIONS:</u>

Cadet 12-13 years old Juniors 14-15 years old

C. Competition Guidelines:

1. Method of Competition:

The competition shall be individual, single elimination.

2. No. of Competitors:

Each LGU may field in a maximum of:

Kyorugi - four (4) players per category **Poomsae -** four (4) entries per category

3. Length of Matches:

Matches shall be 2 rounds of 1.5 minutes per round (no. of rounds and length of matches may change depends on availability of time)

- 4. **Weigh-In:** Weigh-in shall be conducted one day prior to the competition. A preliminary weigh-in shall be allowed before the official and final weigh-in.
- 5. **Coaches:** Only one coach per player shall be allowed in the coach's chair during the matches.
- Competition Codes of Conduct: The Taekwondo Competition Codes of Conduct shall be strictly enforced.
- 7. **Competition Rules:** For all other matters not provided for in these ground rules, the current WTF Kyorugi Competition Rules and Interpretation and the Batang Pinoy guidelines shall apply.
- 8. **Competition Uniform:** Competitors shall wear only the PTA official and recognized brands of Taekwondo V-neck uniform (dobok) during the competition.

NOTE: Use of the "**PHILIPPINES**" print on the uniform is reserved for members of the National Taekwondo Team and for those who have represented the country in international competitions. Otherwise, such usage is strictly prohibited.

9. **Competition Equipment:** Only brands approved by the PTA shall be allowed for use. The contestants shall wear complete protectors during the match (arm & shin guards, groin guard, hand gloves, and mouth guard).

NOTE: In the case where the Daedo PSS will be used, competitors are required to provide their own sensing socks.

10. **Coaches' Attire:** Coaches shall wear the proper attire during the competition. Shorts and slippers are not allowed.

IV. POOMSAE EVENT

A. Qualifications For Participation

1. <u>AFFILIATION:</u> Only players of affiliated clubs, gyms and schools in the advanced division that are in good standing with the Philippine Taekwondo

Association may join the competition. *Participants must be properly accredited or endorsed by their respective LGU's.*

FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT ENTRIES (province or chartered city): Applications shall be coursed through the Sports Office of the LGU. Each LGU may field in a maximum of two (2) entries per category.

- 2. There shall be separate players for Poomsae and Kyorugi. <u>Poomsae</u> players are not allowed to participate in the Kyorugi and vice-versa.
- 3. AGE REQUIREMENT: Players who are 12-15 years old

4. DIVISIONS:

Cadet 12-13 years old Juniors 14-15 years old

C. Method of Competition

The <u>cut-off system</u> shall be applied in this competition. It shall comprise of eliminations, and final rounds:

1. Eliminations:

- Over 16 contestants, top 10 shall qualify for final round
- 11 to 15 contestants, top 8 shall qualify for final round
- 10 contestants and below, shall proceed immediately to Finals
- 2. **Final:** Contestants shall perform the required poomsae for the final round and the top four contestants shall be selected and ranked accordingly.

Note: The organizer may revise the cut-off system in the case when there are less than sixteen participants for the division.

D. Duration of Contest

The time limit for the performance of the required Poomsae in all events (Individual, Team and Pair) shall be 1 minute 30 seconds.

E. General Provisions

- 1. **Competition Codes of Conduct:** The PTA Competition Codes of Conduct shall be strictly enforced.
- 2. *Uniform:* The contestant shall use only the approved <u>Poomsae uniform.</u>
- 3. **Competition Rules:** For all other matters not provided in these competition ground rules, the current WTF Poomsae Competition Rules and Interpretation, shall apply.

V. AWARDS:

Winning contestants shall be awarded the following medals:

First Place - Gold Medal
Second Place - Silver Medal
2 Third Places - Bronze Medal
